In 1963 when the film was released drinking red wine with fish was scorned on, today however more and more wine lovers are enjoying red wine with fish dishes especially oven roast fish, tuna steaks, kebabs of fish ect. Which red wine should be chosen? A very difficult decision. John Matta (Italian Wine Maker of the Year IWSC 1997,2002, 2005 & 2010) who loves red wine decided to develop a specific style from his Tuscan Castello Vicchiomaggio estate. Work on the wine started at the end of 2002 and the definitive blend was decided upon in December 2004 using Sangiovese with 30% Canaiolo. Sangiovese, Tuscany's powerful red grape, with the addition of Canaiolo is fruitier and easier to drink but still retains power and substance, ideal with fish, but also enjoyable with cold meats and pasta.
