

VILLA VALLEMAGGIORE

Situated on the Maremma coast, just seven kilometers from Grosseto and six from the sea. Villa Vallemaggiore estate is a new venture for John Matta and his family who also own the renowned Chianti Classico estate Castello Vicchiomaggio. We asked John Matta "Why this new venture, surely Vicchiomaggio was enough?" His reply: This area was chosen because it has a climate and soil type, totally different from Vicchiomaggio. We are by the sea and there are light breezes all year. The winters are very mild, spring is much earlier than at Greve. The soil is sand and clay with virtually no stone at all. It represents a very interesting challenge. Here we can produce very different wines than those coming from the hills of Greve in Chianti. A very long growing season is ideal for a Sangiovese based wine, we can look forward to rich and intense flavors that maintain and express all their Tuscan heritage and origin.

Campostella: 85% Sangiovese and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon. A youthful, fruit driven wine.
