Aromas of wild herbs and cherry are the hallmarks of this cherry and currant-laced red, backed by a lively structure. The tannins are assertive but this remains balanced in the end.

Red berry, fragrant blue flower, dark spice and a whiff of eucalyptus come together on this one. The taut, structured palate offers dried black cherry, licorice, clove and a hint of grilled sage. Firm, fine-grained tannins and fresh acidity provide balance and support.
